



2018 Spring Snow Goose Hunt Guide

Thank you for booking your hunt with us and here a guide of what you will need and what to do for this spring. ***Please print and sign the release form below and give it to your guide on the morning of your first hunt. Also keep the contact information.***

Prior to your hunt

Call, text, or email me about 7 days prior to your hunt date so we can see weather forecast to determine where we will be hunting so you can make hotel reservations. Rooms are plentiful in AR at that time so don't be alarmed. If you are scheduled to hunt MO you may want to make reservations soon in Maryville that can be later cancelled if that isn't our destination. Maryville is the only town that is tough to get lodging.

Remember to Call the AR GFP to get registered to hunt the Spring Conservation season.

Things to bring

- Recommended 3-4 boxes of 3" BB-2's for each day you hunt
- Un-plugged guns, extension tubes recommended. Spring is not a time to conserve on shells.
- Dress for any type of weather
- Knee boots with waterproof bibs - pants or waders. Watch the weather and use your judgement if you need wader.
- Face mask or face paint is highly recommended.
- Snacks and drinks. You come and go as you like during the day to have lunch, etc.
- Zero tolerance of alcohol or drugs in the field before or during the hunt.
- Release form printed out, signed, and dated for each member of your hunting party.

Final payment options

All funds must be paid prior to entering the field.

- The final balance is due in cash. Since time is limited in the morning please have cash ready in 1 envelope from 1 person in the group.
- Credit Card - If you don't wish to deal with cash you can pay with credit card the night before or sooner. There will be a 2.5% convenience fee for credit card.
- Absolutely no checks for payment after Jan 20th as I will no longer be at my house for 1 Month.

What you decide to tip is up to you but please don't determine the amount by how many birds you kill but to how your hunt was conducted and did your guide do everything possible to get birds even on the tough days when birds won't decoy no matter what they do. If you decide to tip please tip at end of each day as there is no guarantee that you will have same guide each day. Thanks

RELEASE, INDEMNIFICATION AND HOLD HARMLESS AGREEMENT

In consideration of participating in hunting activities, and for other good and valuable consideration, I hereby agree to release and discharge from liability arising from negligence Waterfowl Junkie Outdoors and its owners, ALL LANDOWNERS, LEASE HOLDERS, directors, officers, employees, agents, volunteers, participants, and all other persons or entities acting for them (hereinafter collectively referred to as "Releases'"), on behalf of myself and my children, parents, heirs, assigns, personal representative and estate, and also agree as follows:

1. I acknowledge that hunting activities involve known and unanticipated risks which could result in physical or emotional injury, paralysis or permanent disability, death, and property damage. Risks include, but are not limited to qualities of the activity.
2. I expressly accept and assume all the risks inherent in this activity or that might have been caused by the negligence of the Releases'. My participation in this activity is purely voluntary and I elect to participate despite the risks. In addition, if at any time I believe that event conditions are unsafe or that I am unable to participate due to physical or medical conditions, then I will immediately discontinue participation.
3. I hereby voluntarily release, forever discharge, and agree to indemnify and hold harmless Releases' from my and all claims, demands, or causes of action which are in any way connected with my participation in this activity, or my use of their equipment or facilities, arising from negligence. This release does not apply to claims arising from intentional conduct. Should Releases' or anyone acting on their behalf be required to incur attorney's fees and costs to enforce this agreement, I agree to indemnify and hold them harmless for all such fees and costs.
4. I represent that I have adequate insurance to cover any injury or damage I may suffer or cause while participating in this activity, or else I agree to bear the costs of such injury or damage myself. I further represent that I have no medical or physical condition which could interfere with my safety in this activity, or else I am willing to assume-and bear the costs of- all risks that may be created, directly or indirectly, by any such condition.
5. In the event that I file a lawsuit, I agree to do so solely in the state where Releases' facility is located, and I further agree that the substantive law of that state shall apply.
6. I agree that if any portion of this agreement is found to be void or unenforceable, the remaining portions shall remain in full force and effect.

By Signing this document, I agree that if I am hurt or my property is damaged during my participation in this activity, then I may be found by a court of law to have waived my right to maintain a lawsuit against the parties being released on the basis of any claim for negligence.

I have had sufficient time to read this entire document and, should I choose to do so, consult with legal counsel prior to signing. Also, I understand that this activity might not be made available to me or that the cost to engage in this activity would be significantly greater if I were to choose not to sign this release, and agree that the opportunity to participate at the stated cost in return for the execution of this release is a reasonable bargain. I have read and understand this document and I agree to be bound by its terms.
